ELIGIBILITY

To be eligible for our services, pet owners must meet at least one of the following criteria:

- Provide proof of low income status and fall within 150% of the Federal Poverty Line as defined by the U.S. Federal Poverty Guideline.

OR

- Provide proof of assistance from one of the following state programs:

KanCare	SSI/SSDI
Medicaid	Medicare
TANF	SNAP

Please fill out the application completely and *include required documentation*. Incomplete applications will delay approval. If there is a problem and we cannot reach you, the application will be marked as inactive until resolved. You will be contacted as soon as possible to schedule your appointments.



